The Sunset Mountain Fish & Game Club, Inc. is located just east after exiting the I-93, exit #18, in Canterbury.

Facilities:

Clubhouse with meeting room and a 50 foot indoor heated range. Only non-magnum pistol calibers using non-jacketed lead bullets are allowed on the indoor range.

Outdoor Range:

50 Yard Pistol Range

100, 200, 300 and 500 yard Rifle Ranges.

All calibers are allowed except 50 BMG. Full-automatic weapons are not allowed.

Clay target shooting is allowed in a restricted area.

The outdoor range is open year round except for Thanksgiving and Christmas.

- o New Members must complete the Safety Orientation with our Safety Officer before being authorized to use the facilities and receiving membership card, By-Laws, Club Policy Document & Range Safety Rules. Dates and times for these sessions can be arranged with the Safety Officer after membership meeting.
