Facilities:

Clubhouse with meeting room and a 50 foot indoor heated range. Only non-magnum pistol caliber bullets are allowed on the indoor range.

Outdoor Range:

50 Yard Pistol Range

100, 200, 300, and 500 yard Rifle Ranges.

All calibers are allowed Full-automatic weapons are not allowed.

Clay target shooting is allowed in a restricted area.

The outdoor range is open year round except for Thanksgiving and Christmas and during icing conditions.

- Membership fees are due and payable by December 31st each year. A late charge of \$30.00 will be assessed on all dues paid after December 31st. Should a member's dues be unpaid by January 31st, all membership privileges are revoked.
- New Members should have a sponsor who is a current member in good standing. OR you may submit a letter listing previous club/organization memberships, personal references, letters of reference from previous shooting club(s), letters of reference from known prominent persons, list all shooting experience, etc.
- A current criminal background check or current Concealed Weapon Permit must also be shown.
- New Members must complete the Safety Orientation with our Safety Officer before being authorized to use the facilities and receiving membership card and must abide by the By-Laws, Club Policy Document & Range Safety Rules. Dates and times for these sessions can be arranged with the Safety Officer after membership meeting.
